More recently, the EURADOS Winter School was included to respond to the need for training in the field of radiation dosimetry.

## 4th EURADOS Winter School "Radiological emergencies – Internal exposures"

3 February 2010

Aula Pocchiari – Istituto Superiore di Sanità

### Scope

The 4th EURADOS winter school is dedicated to emergency preparedness. Several scenarios which involve deliberate or accidental release of radioactive material or other malevolent use of radiation are imaginable or did already happen. Being prepared to perform a rapid and valid survey and assessment of emergency situations is an important step to a successful response averting as much radiation detriment as possible. Important issues to be prepared for include monitoring and dosimetry, medical aspects and decision making. The lessons learned from real and training cases need to be carefully considered by the responders' strategies.

The series of EURADOS Winter Schools provides an opportunity for non-specialists to gain knowledge in selected topics of general interest in the field of radiation dosimetry. It allows those not working in that particular field to get insight in state-of-the-art techniques and new scientific developments, and it is also well suited for those starting to work in this area. The topic is covered by tutorial lectures given by renowned experts.

Participants of the Winter School will receive a certificate of attendance.

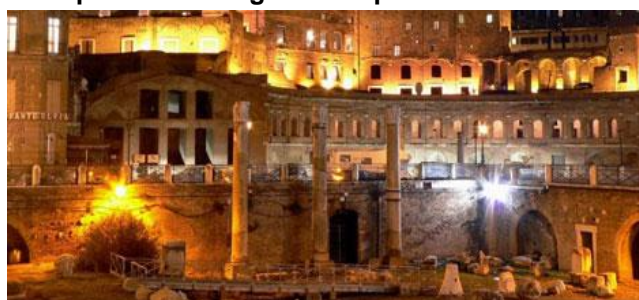
### Conference guided tour

The complex of the *Mercati di Traiano* are one of the most famous archaeological sites in Rome. This area has experienced the evolution of the city from the imperial age to today. The markets once the strategic administrative centre of the Imperial Forums, successively became a noble residence, a military fortress, a prestigious convent and a barracks.

**The City of Rome will extraordinarily open this unique archaeological complex to the Eurados AM guests on Wednesday, at 19:00. Access to the complex is possible only by a guided tour, the cost of which will be 5 euro for Eurados guests.**

The *Mercati di Traiano* are within a walking distance from the conference dinner location. Due to organizational reasons, **we kindly ask you to book your visit at the registration desk** on Monday or on your first day.



#### Route info:

go to piazzale Valerio Massimo stop *Tiburtina/Valerio Massimo* and take line 71 to 14 stops; get off at stop *Milano/Nazionale*, and:

- For *Mercati di Traiano*: walk 550 meters to via IV novembre, 94
- For “*Terrazza Caffarelli*”: walk 100 meters and go to stop *Nazionale/Palazzo Esposizioni*, take line 170 to 3 stops. Get off at stop *Teatro Marcello/Ara Coeli*. Walk 300 meters to piazzale Caffarelli, 4.

### How to reach ISS

#### - Airport "Leonardo da Vinci" (Fiumicino)

Rome's main airport is well-connected to the centre of town during the day by two train services:

- *Leonardo Express* train service running every half hour to Rome's Termini Station (journey time - 35 minutes). ticket costs € 11,00 and can be purchased at vending machines, ticket offices and other vendors at both Termini and Fiumicino.

Schedule: every 30 minutes

- Metropolitan Trains *FM1* stop at local stations on the way to Tiburtina. When you are at the airport train station look for the train to "Orte" or "Fara Sabina". It is cheaper but slower as it stops at the local stations along the way. Does not stop at Termini. Trains take about 45 minutes to reach Tiburtina Station (very close to the ISS). Tickets cost € 5,50.

Schedule: every 20 minutes

#### - Airport "G.B. Pastine" (Ciampino)

A smaller airport dealing mainly with charter flights and budget airlines. It is connected to Line A metro station Anagnina (about 30 minutes by metro from Termini) by Cotral buses; ticket costs € 1,03. Buses leave every 30-60 minutes.

Buses 492, 163, 443 or 448. Get off at the second stop (Via Tiburtina/Piazza Valerio Massimo). This station is just about 10 minutes walk from the Institute.

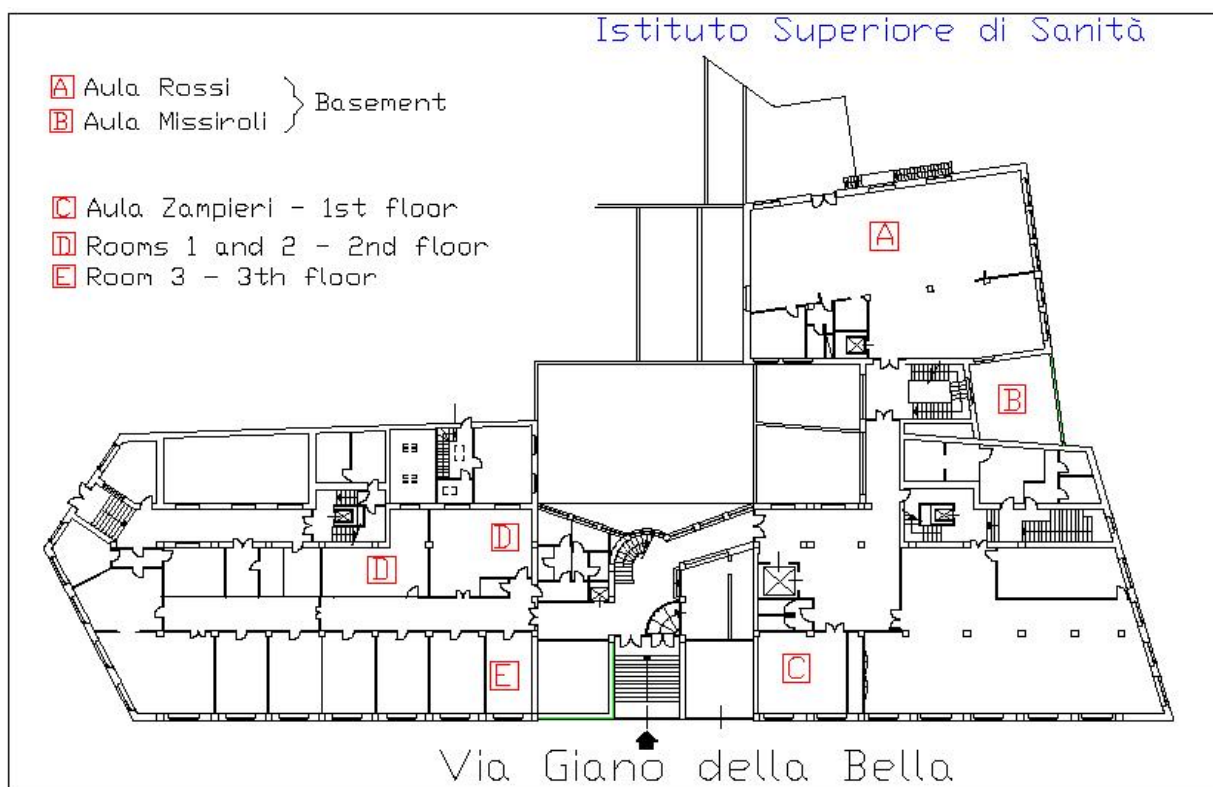
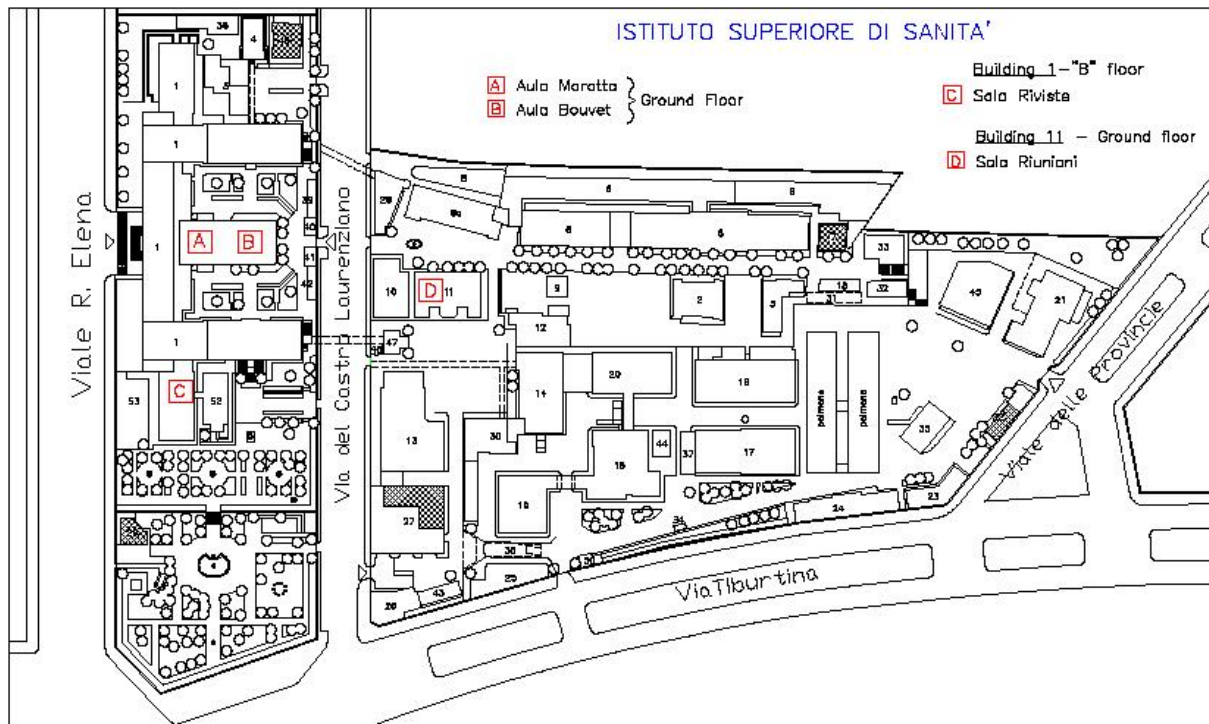

## ISS buildings

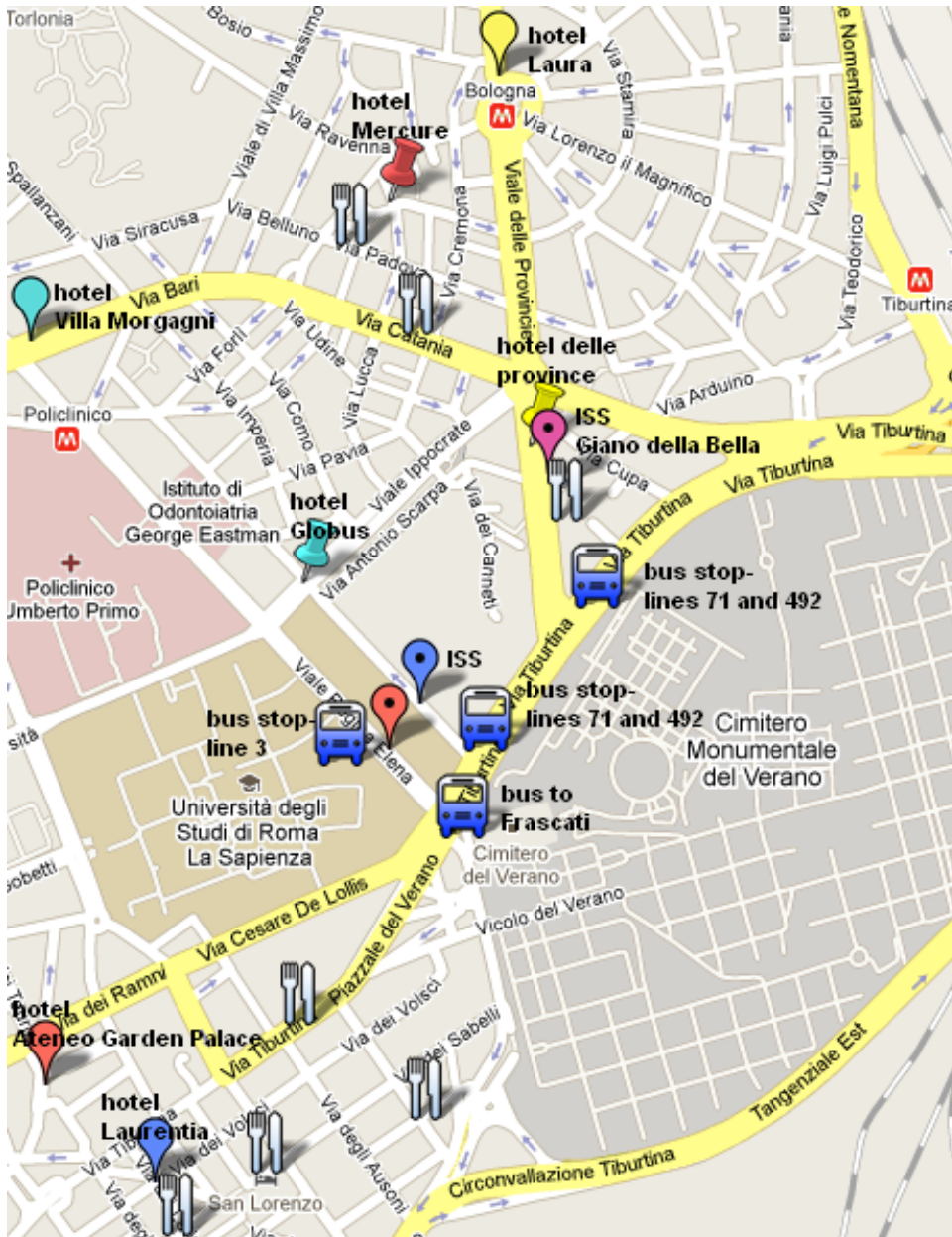


## Iss surrounding area

### ARCHEOBUS

The archeobus is a bus that circulates through Rome stopping at many of the major archaeological sites. It costs a very reasonable 7.75 Euro to ride the archeobus all day. A bilingual (Italian-English) guide on the bus describes what's at each stop. You can get on or off anywhere.
